Volunteer responsibilities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Read the Melbourne AMEP Volunteer Handbook - Meet at a pre-arranged time each week - Log your volunteering hours and client encounters each week via the My Impact page. - Carry out the sessions you've agreed to do responsibly, reliably and ethically—this includes respecting the rights and privacy of others. - Contact VTS staff if you are concerned about a student's welfare - Inform VTS Office if your availability changes - Give two weeks' notice before withdrawing from the program - Complete an Exit Survey
